In this meeting HMIS report for the month of January 2024 was analyzed and the following points are highlighted in the meeting as well as action points to be taken.

1. Antenatal registration in 1st trimester: Total ANC registration for the month of January is 155. Out of this, registration within 1st trimester is only 60%.

Amongst the 35 HWC and SCs there are 8 facilities who performed very poor, viz,.

2. Sumsilui HWC 40%

3. Saizawh W HWC 44.4%

It can be seen that, out of 8 facilities with low performance in the 1st trimester registration of pregnant women, 7 of them are HWC posted with HWO/MO Ayush, it seem that these facilities needs to try and improve regarding this indicator, and Supportive supervision and monitoring is badly needed.

2. IFA 180 tablet distribution: - out of the total ANC registration only 39.1% received IFA 180 tablets during January, 2024.

Regarding this indicator, it is very clear that, the achievement cannot be that high as it can be seen that out of 35 facilities 34.2% of the facilities has 0% achievement.

- 4. Deliveries: The total Home delivery is 40% % and the institutional delivery is 59.9%. In this the institutional delivery is slightly lower than the previous month, but regarding last year and the previous year we have seen improvement in institutional delivery
- Home Based Newborn Care (HBNC): The total HBNC achievement is 61.2%. A slight improvement is seen in this, out of total home deliveries only 40.66% received HBNC and out of total institutional deliveries only 72.79% received HBNC.
- 6. Fully immunized below 1 year of age: the district achievement regarding this indicator for the month of January 2024, is 84.68% against live birth which is not as expected, and hope to improve in the coming months.
- 7. IDSP- Lawngtlai district ranked 1<sup>st</sup> in IHIP reporting again and the members congratulate the DDM,IDSP for his continuous good performance and hopes to do well in the future as well.
- 8. Grievance redressed During this meeting one grievance was discussed i.e grievance regarding unavailability of CDR reporting formats .The members concluded that this grievance be brought up to DHT meeting for printing of this reporting forms as soon as possible.
